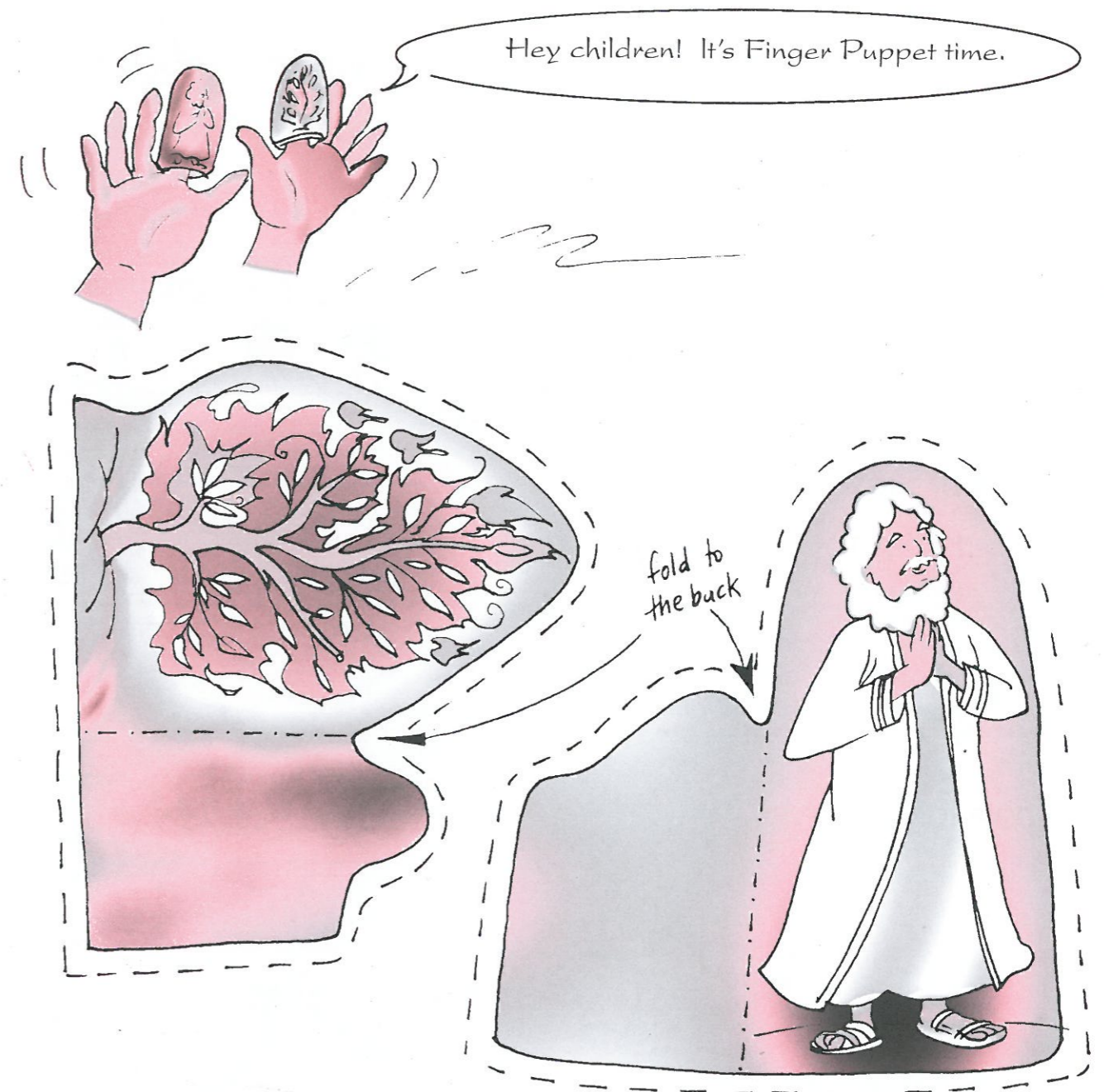


Let us pray:
