The healing of blind Bartimaeus

Narrator : After Jesus had been teaching his disciples he went to a town called Jericho. He spent some time there and was now leaving with his disciples and a great crowd that followed him. Then something happened.

Bartimaeus : *(Pushing his way through the crowd on his knees)* What is all the noise, who is it that is passing by?

1st Bystander : Jesus of Nazareth the healer and great teacher.

Bartimaeus : *(Shouting)* Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me.

2nd Bystander: Be quiet. He is too busy, there is such a great crowd.

Bartimaeus : *(Shouting even louder)* Son of David, have mercy on me.

Jesus : *(Kindly)* Bring the man to me.

3rd Bystander: Take heart, get up, he is calling you.

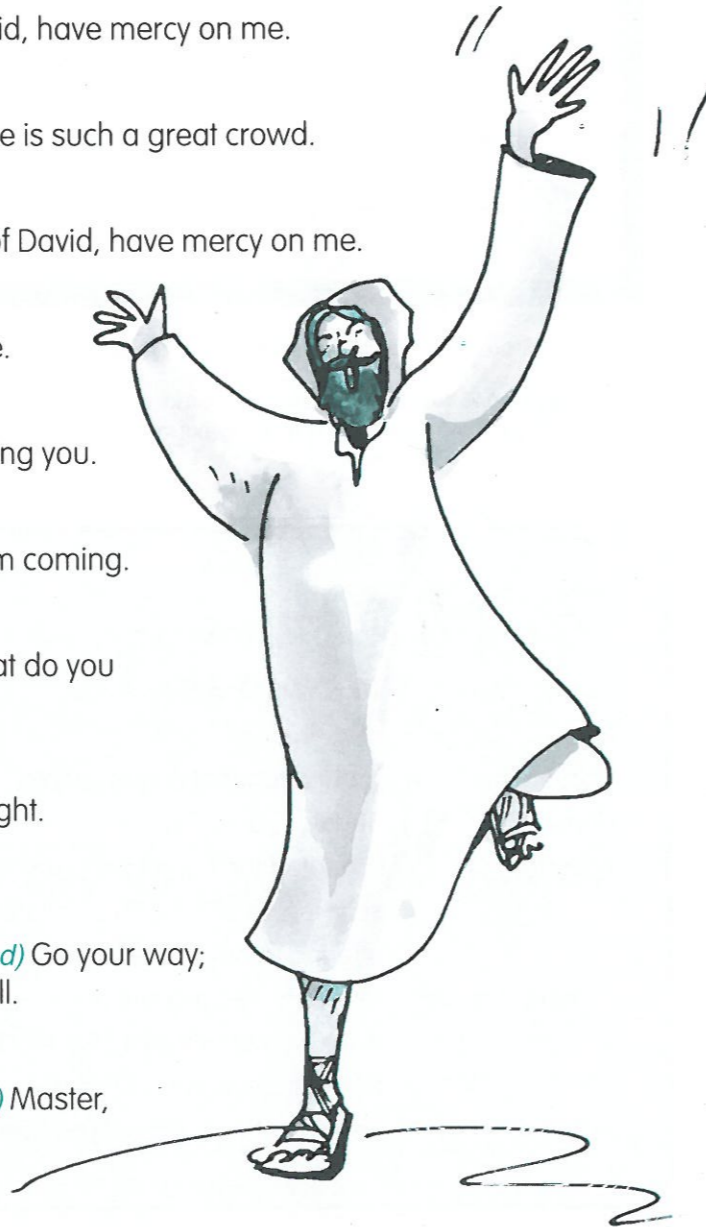
Bartimaeus : *(Jumping up full of hope)* I am coming.
