(I'm singin' -) Chorus

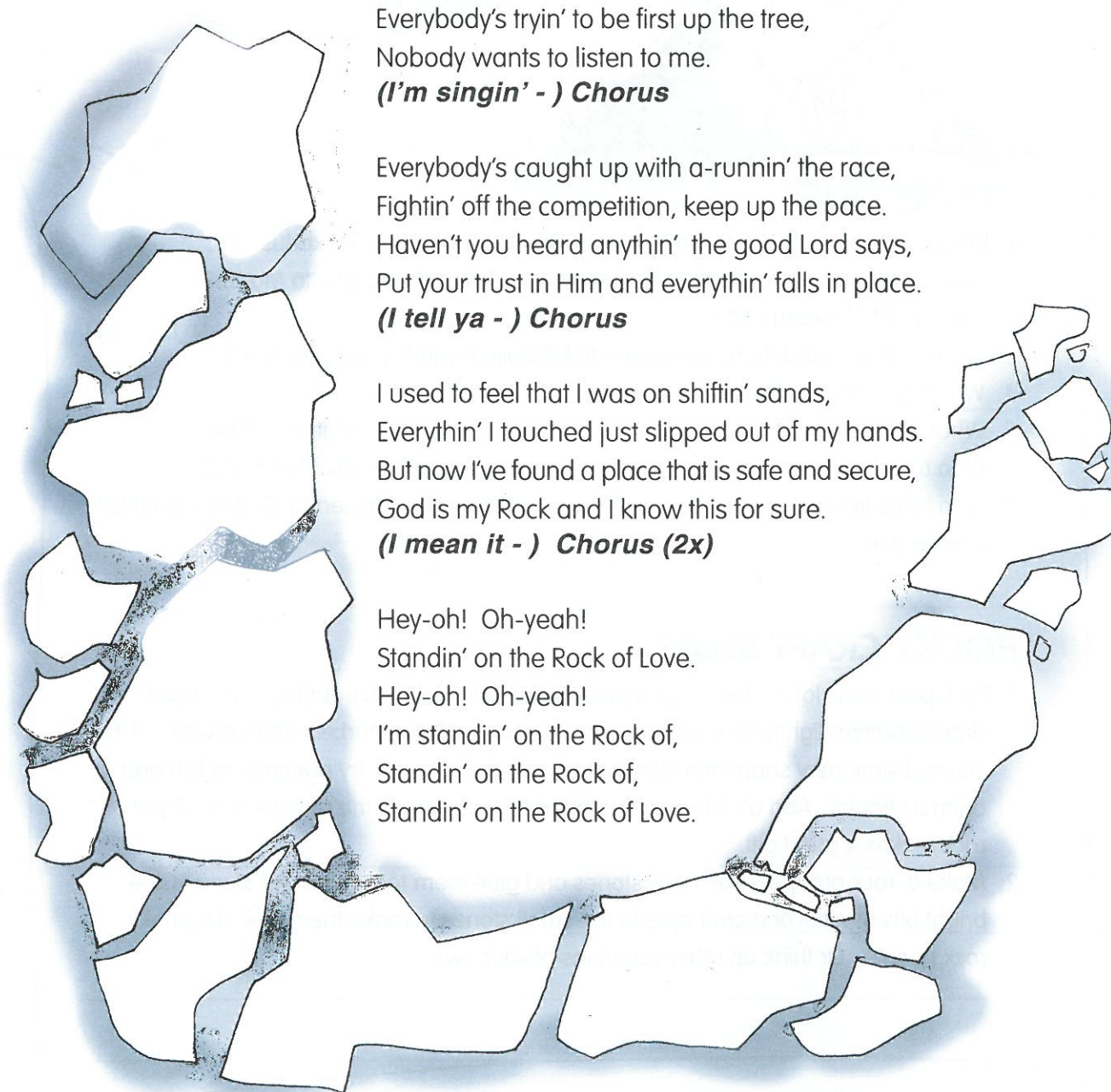
Everybody's caught up with a-runnin' the race,

Worksheet 8.1

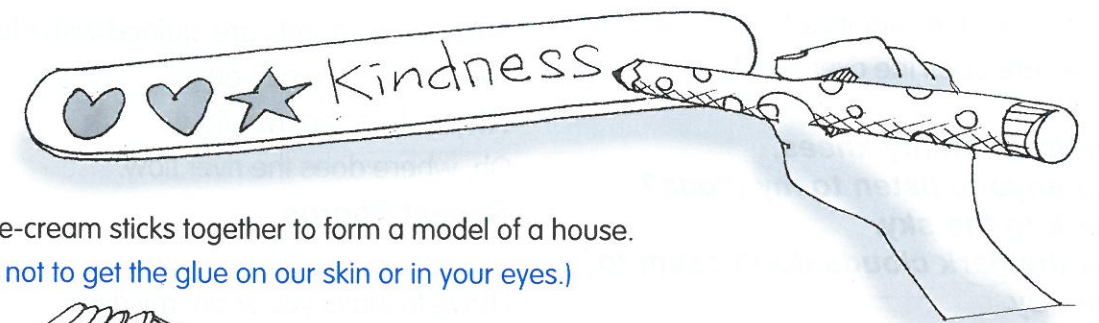
Matthew 7:24-27

Reflect

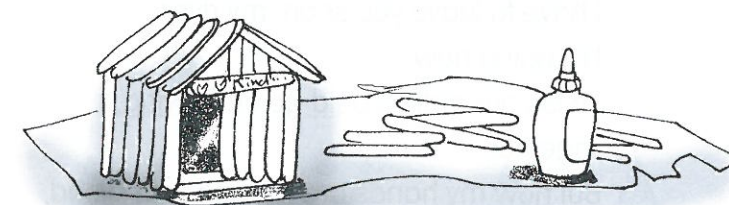
What actions can you take to 'build' your life on the rock of God? Share your ideas with your small group.
