<i>Bread - Jesus is present in the breaking of the Bread</i> Lesson 18 On the Emmaus road	Children learn that Cleopas and his friend recognised Jesus was present in the breaking of bread.	Luke 24:13-35

<i>God is ever ready to forgive us.</i> Lesson 19 The two sons (The prodigal son)	Children learn that God is a loving father who readily forgives us.	Luke 15:1-32
<i>God forgives all sinners.</i> Lesson 20 Jesus forgives the sinful woman	Children learn that Jesus forgives all sinners and we have no right to condemn them, instead we should encourage them when they are sorry for their sins.	Luke 7:36-50
<i>God takes pity on his children.</i> Lesson 21 The runaway (Jonah)	Children learn that God is a loving father who gave us life and feels sorry for us when we sin.	Jonah 1-4

<i>Forgiving others</i> Lesson 22 Ezekiel and the exiles	Children learn that even when it seems that we have gone far away from God, and given up hope, God forgives us, breathes new life into us and brings us back to him.	Ezekiel 37:1-14
<i>Forgiving others as God forgives us</i> Lesson 23 The prayer of Jesus (Our Father)	Children learn the 'Our Father and that since God forgives us, we should forgive others too.	Matthew 6:7-15
<i>Jesus forgives those who hurt him.</i> Lesson 24 Jesus was sentenced to death	Children learn that Jesus forgave those who put him to death.	Luke 23:32-49 Luke 23:34
<i>Forgiving our enemies</i> Lesson 25 Jesus is alive, we can follow him.	Children learn that Jesus said many things about himself and taught many difficult things but he showed us that everything is possible with God's help.	John 20:1-10 Luke 24:1-11
<i>Jesus heals us and forgives our sins</i> Lesson 26 The paralysed man	Children learn that for Jesus forgiving us is an important part of healing us.	Mark 2:1-12
<i>Jesus forgives and heals. He opens our eyes to know him better.</i> Lesson 27 A man born blind	Children learn that when Jesus forgives our sins and heals us, he opens our eyes and hearts to see and know him better.	John 9:1-41
<i>Forgiveness (healing)</i> Lesson 28 Healing at the pool of Bethesda	Pupils learn that Jesus forgives us and his forgiveness heals the whole person.	John 5:2-14
