Lesson 16 Jesus teaches us to pray	To help pupils pray the Lord's Prayer meaningfully.	Luke 11:1-12; Matthew 6:7-14
Lesson 17 The importance of prayer in our lives	To help pupils realize the importance of prayer in their lives.	Worksheet 17.1
Lesson 18 Love and compassion	Pupils learn to show love and compassion for others like Jesus did.	Mark 1:40-45 2:13-17 6:30-44 8:1-10 Luke 19:1-10
Lesson 19 Giving from your heart	To help pupils be aware that when they give, what counts is their sincerity and generosity of heart.	Mark 12:41-44

Lesson 21 Listening to Jesus	To give pupils a chance to meet Jesus in prayer rather than just talking about him.	Mark 10:13-16
Lesson 22 Gathered at the table with Jesus	To help pupils realize that Jesus is really present, talking to us, giving us to eat and drink in the Mass and making us his closest friends.	Mark 14:17-26
Lesson 23 Jesus loved his friends	To show how Jesus loved his friends even when they let him down.	Eucharistic Prayer
Lesson 24 Jesus laid down his life for his friends	To appreciate that Jesus died for us so that we could all become his brothers and sisters and love his Father..	Mark 15:16 - 41
