Lesson 9 God prepares Moses	To introduce the life of Moses to the class. To show how God prepared Moses for his role.	Exodus 2:1-22
Lesson 10 God remembers his Covenant	Isaiah 49:13-16 To help pupils understand that God established a special relationship with his people and he remains faithful to it.	Exodus 2:23 to 3:10
Lesson 11 Moses, the reluctant prophet	To help pupils understand how God helps us overcome our fears of being called, by reassuring and helping us each step of the way as he promised.	Exodus 3:9 to 4:17

Lesson 12 The night of Passover	To help pupils understand the meaning of Passover and to show that the blood of the Lamb symbolizes the saving power of God who protects his people.	Exodus 12:1-14
Lesson 13 Moses leads God's People	To help the pupils gain an insight into the God who journeys with us so patiently and powerfully.	Exodus 14:5-31
Lesson 14 God frees his People	To help pupils reflect on the behaviour of the Israelites in order to see how God wants to free us too from everything that enslaves us.	Exodus 16:1-15
Lesson 15 God seals the Covenant	To help pupils realize the significance of the Sinai event which shows the sealing of the covenant between God and his People.	Exodus 19:1-11
Lesson 16 God gives his people Ten Commandments	To give pupils a greater appreciation of the Ten Commandments as part of a covenant signed with God who insists that his people live in a particular way that he points out.	Exodus 20:1-17
Lesson 17 God renews his Covenant	To help pupils understand the patience of God with his people and his willingness to let us start again, to give us a new heart to live again as his people.	Ezekiel 36:24-28

Lesson 20 Jesus is risen as he promised	To help pupils enter into the joy and hope of the Risen Lord.	Luke 24: 13-35
Lesson 21 Living the way of the new Covenant	To help pupils see that there is a way of living that is appropriate to the joy we feel at the resurrection.	Colossians 3: 12-17
