#### **EVENTS**

## a) An evening of prayer with Bro Alois of Taizé.

The prayer session was arranged on 29<sup>th</sup> January at the Cathedral of the Good Shepherd. Bro Alois, Prior of Taizé, was passing through Singapore on his way to the "Pilgrimage of Trust" in Manila and was invited to pray with young people from our schools and Junior College. The Cathedral was packed.

- b) Principals' Commissioning & Service of Commitment, Saturday,23 Jan 2010
  The Commissioning was conducted at the Church of the Holy Family during the Sunset Mass. His Grace commissioned 18 principals, of whom 13 were from Catholic Kindergartens. A total of 70 principals and vice-principals renewed their commitment to service in Catholic Education. Dinner was hosted by the archbishop after the Mass in the Church canteen.
- c) Teachers' Day Celebration 'You are the Salt of the Earth'
  The Celebration was held at SJI International, Thomson Road. More than 300 educators from Catholic and other schools, attended the celebration which included a Sunset Mass and tea reception. The theme adopted this year was 'You are the Salt of the Earth'. His Grace Presided at mass and Monsignor Vaz and Fr Gerard Louis CSsR concelebrated. The choir was from St Gabriel's Secondary School conducted by Mr Marcel Lee, the Principal.
